Why should I attend this clinic?

- negotiating technical terrain and obstacles
- in-hand presentation for veterinary checks
- pulse and respiration stops
- conditioning methods
- trail equitation and etiquette
- safe camping and trailer evaluation

Driving Directions:

From Newcastle, NE Hwy 12

Go 4.2 miles to NE Spur 15N, turn right or north only. Go 1.5 miles north to 579 Ave., which will be on your left as you are heading north. Take this 2.7 miles to Turkey Creek Ranch. You will pass a white house on the right side. Slow down as the Turkey Creek entrance is just around the corner.

From SD Hwy 50, West of Vermillion, SD

Take SD Hwy 19 south only. Once you cross the Missouri River bridge into Nebraska, the turn is approximately one mile. Turn right onto 579 Ave. Take this 2.7 miles to Turkey Creek Ranch as described above.

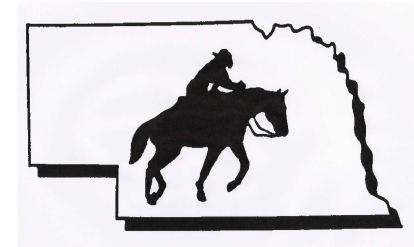
The campground offers 20 electrical hookups, covered pavilion, water, port-a-pots and horse pens.

What to bring:

If you are riding in the clinic:

- 1 – horse
- 2 – tack (halter, lead rope, longe line, saddle, saddle pad, bridle)
- 3 – helmet (mandatory if rider is under 18)
- 4 – wristwatch
- 5 – bottle of water
- 6 – note pad and pen
- 7 – bug spray for you and your horse
- 8 – water bucket and hay

If you are auditing:

- 1 – lawn chair
- 2 – note pad and pen
- 3 – bottle of water
- 4 – wristwatch with second hand, if you would like to help with Pulse and Respiration checks on the horses
- 5 – bug spray

Other requirements:

A horse that is:
current on vaccinations,
minimum age of 4-years-old
able to be ridden in a group at walk/trot
not a stallion

A responsible adult rider if children are participating. Youth must be 10-years-old or older.
